

Free Legal Help

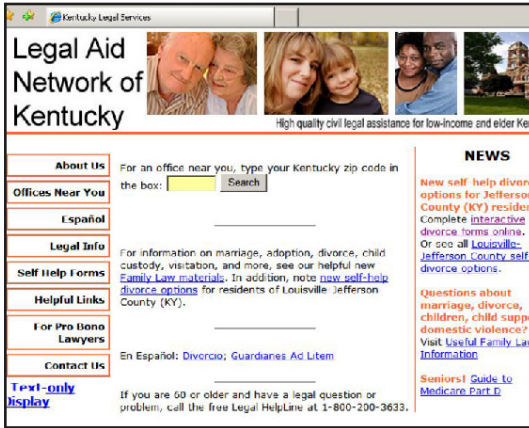
If you can't afford an attorney and need help filling out forms for your uncontested divorce, criminal record expungement, or small claims case, the Kentucky Online Self-Help Assistant (KOSHA) may be able to help you. KOSHA makes it easy for you to complete and file court forms yourself.

step 1: get started

Type www.kyjustice.org into the address bar as seen below, and then hit enter.



You will then see a page that looks similar to this:

step 2: Select your program

On the right-hand side of the page, you will see an option to access the uncontested divorce, expungement, or small claim forms. Click on the name of the forms you would like to use.

step 3: begin your interview

Begin answering the questions you see on the screen. Follow the directions carefully.



Step 4: print your forms

Click "finished" when you are done answering the questions. The forms you need to file with the court will be printed for you.

Step 5: File your forms

Follow the instructions on the website. Take your completed forms and fees to your Circuit Court Clerk for filing.
